Notice of Intent	Clinton Conservation Commission (Pursuant to Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act)	Work in jurisdictional wetland resource areas
Massachusetts Endangered Species Act Project Review Checklist	Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program (NHESP)	Work in mapped rare species habitat
Project Notification Form	Massachusetts Historical Commission (MHC)	Review of potential impacts to historic or archaeological resources
Pre-Construction Notification (Massachusetts General Permits)	U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE)	Work in Waters of the United States (including wetlands)
****Water Quality Certification	Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (Pursuant to the federal Clean Water Act)	Work in Waters of the United States (including wetlands)
